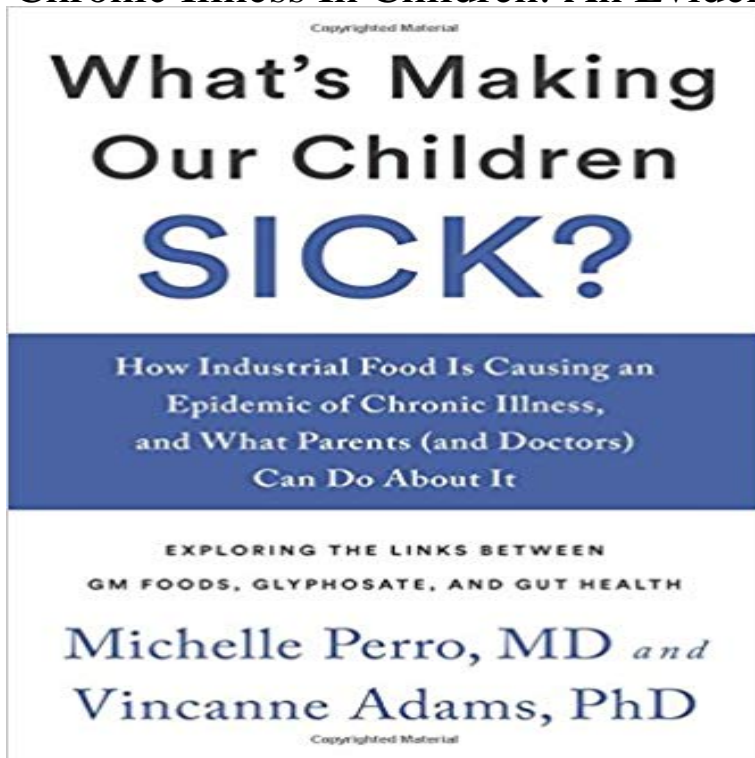


# Chronic Illness In Children: An Evidence-based Approach
